Matt's 23-24 Budget Wrap

BIG NEWS: Last year I made a lot of exciting local commitments and I'm very happy to report that we are delivering on each and every one!

The recent budget delivers on what matters most to our community, right here in the Ashwood District.

Here's what the budget means for our community:

- \$5.86 million upgrade at Mount Waverley Primary School
- \$5.3 million to upgrade and modernise Parkhill Primary School
- Funding to plan a school hall upgrade at Pinewood Primary School
- \$1.5 million towards improving the Waverley Rail Trail between Mount Waverley and Jordanville Railway Stations
- Funding to commence the roll-out of zero emission buses

- \$2.5 million for a Chinese Community Centre in the East
- Funding to support Holmesglen Education First Youth Foyer to continue rental supplementation supporting young people
- \$1.3 million for covered courts at the Waverley District Netball Association
- A new fenced dog park in Mount Waverley
- \$80,000 for Alamein Neighbourhood and Learning Centre



- \$125,000 towards a new scoreboard and moveable player shelter at Ashburton Reserve
- New neighbourhood battery for Monash
- \$50,000 towards a new shaded seating area at Ashburton Bowls Club
- \$50,000 for upgrades at Mount Waverley Bowling Club
- \$1.0 million grant for Monash Council to improve Scotchmans Creek Trail near Warrigal Road and Blackburn Road

I'm absolutely thrilled to have secured funding for all of these local projects and more. Our community deserves nothing less and I look forward to keeping you up to date on all of these big wins!

Education

Premier Visits Ashwood High School

The State Member for Ashwood District, Matt Fregon MP was joined by Premier Daniel Andrews when he dropped into Ashwood High School for a sneak peek of the new STEAM and Research Centre, due to open next year.

The tour was hosted by Principal Dr. Brett Moore, Assistant Principal Meg McLellan, Executive Assistant Donna Mineo, and student captains Sebastian Millan, Carol Yuan, and Stephanie Millan. The visit also included engaging interactions with teachers and students, and discussions on the school's diverse educational offerings.

The new centre reflects the school's commitment to fostering innovation and excellence in Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics.



Mount Waverley Primary School

The latest Victorian State Budget has allocated \$5.86 million for the upgrade and modernisation of the North Building at Mount Waverley Primary School. Matt Fregon MP was on-site at the school in May this year, alongside Assistant Principal Tania Hunter, to formally make the announcement.

This funding is part of an effort to invest in local schools, with a focus on creating an optimal learning environment for our local students.



Parkhill Primary School Upgrades!

Back in November 2022, Matt Fregon MP was joined by Minister for Education Natalie Hutchins MP at Parkhill Primary School in Ashwood for an exciting pre-election announcement. The Andrews Government pledged to invest \$5.3 million to upgrade and modernise the school, including improvements to the playground, landscaping, fencing and acoustics in the gymnasium.

As part of the 2023/24 State Budget, this funding promise was delivered, with \$5.3 million allocated to ensure this fantastic school continues to grow and provide the modern learning spaces our local students deserve.

This funding builds on the \$9.7 million already invested to make Parkhill Primary an outstanding local school for the Ashwood community.

Matt would also like to welcome and introduce new school Principal, Jo Jolley, who he looks forward to working closely with in the coming months.



Pinewood Primary School One Step Closer to a New Gym and Music Space!

Following the State Budget announcement back in May, it was announced that planning will commence this year for a new competition-grade gymnasium and music space at Pinewood Primary School!

This much-needed upgrade will provide students with a gymnasium to stay active and pursue their passions in music and the arts. This is part of a broader effort to upgrade our local schools to ensure our children have the brightest possible future.



Mount Waverley Secondary College Full STEAM Ahead!

Back in June, Matt Fregon MP was welcomed by MWSC Principal Karen Wade and Middle School Principal Ian MacLeod for a progress tour of the \$7.9 million STEAM Centre.

The new facility will be a place that fosters culture and innovation and leadership through the creation and sharing of ideas. This STEAM building demonstrates the college's dedication to enhancing current infrastructure to develop a crucial technological environment that will provide students with an advanced educational approach and will be a centrepiece for Mount Waverley – as you come down Stephensons Road, it is there for all to see.

Free TAFE

Container Deposit Scheme - A Win-Win for the Environment and the Community

Waverley Netball Association Court Covers

The Waverley District Netball Association is set to receive a significant boost with an allocation of \$1.30 million in the Victorian Government's May budget. This funding will facilitate the construction of much-needed court covers for the local netballers.

The investment is a big win for the community, as it will ensure that players have better playing conditions and can train and compete irrespective of the weather. Not only does this show support and recognition for netball as a sport, but it also reflects the government's commitment to enhancing local sports facilities. The court covers are expected to greatly benefit the local netball community.



New Lights Shine on Ashburton Sport

Ashburton's soccer and cricket players are set to shine both day and night, thanks to a lighting upgrade at Warner Reserve sports ground, backed by the Victorian Government.

Member for Ashwood Matt Fregon MP joined representatives of Ashburton United Soccer Club and the Boroondara City Council, to officially switch on the new lighting, made possible by a more than \$144,000 investment from the Victorian Government's World Game Facilities Fund.

Soccer is one of Victoria's fastest growing sports, and Warner Reserve is at the heart of the action for the more than 760 members of Ashburton United Soccer Club.

The new 100 lux LED lighting will bring the reserve up to Football Victoria standards and allow Ashburton Soccer Club to expand its programs and also include an Access for All Abilities Soccer Team, Go Mums and Masters programs, Junior National Premier League training, and a Pride Cup tournament.

The lights will also allow the club to offer training for multiple teams at once, helping build a more social family atmosphere at the club, and supporting the growth of both the membership and volunteer bases that are critical to ongoing growth.

The fun won't stop with soccer, as the lights will support pre-season training for the more than 1,000 members of Glen Iris Cricket Club, Ashburton Willows Cricket Club, STC South Camberwell Cricket Club and Camberwell Magpies Junior Cricket Club, and provide better facilities for use by local schools including Ashburton Primary School, St Michael's Primary School and Solway Primary School.

Matt Fregon MP acknowledged Boroondara City Council for its commitment and financial contribution of more than \$144,000 to the project.

Reus secured the crucial catch and bowled a wicket on the last ball of the day against the Croydon Ranges CC Vets' team. Reus is considered a legend in the Burwood District Cricket Club, not only for his exceptional achievements but also for his competitive spirit, determination, loyalty, and longevity. He has played the most games and taken the most wickets in the club.

In comparison to other players in the Box Hill Reporter District Cricket Association (BHRDCA), Reus holds significant records. He has played 46 seasons in the BHRDCA, surpassing the previous record of 39 seasons. Reus is believed to hold the BHRDCA record for the most games played. Reaching 1,000 wickets, Reus joins a small group of four others.

Adrian Reus's career summary with the Burwood District Cricket Club includes 502 games, 4,095 runs, and 1,000 wickets. He has been a dedicated member of the club for over four decades, creating lasting friendships and memories along the way.

Project update and timeline:

- Sportsground redevelopment design completed.
 Including turf wicket, oval lighting, pathway, seating, goal posts, oval fencing and behind the goal netting.
- Sportsground redevelopment construction. Monash City Council aim to award the project at the August Council meeting and start construction 1 Nov 2023.
- · Playground design completed.
- Playground construction to commence March 2024.
- Pavilion construction to commence April 2024.

A huge shout out to the Carina Garland MP, Minister Ros Spence, the Waverley Blues, Mount Waverley Cricket Club, Presidents Stephen Pewtress and David Grossman, their committees and members for working with all levels of government to see this project become a reality.

Transport

Zero Emission Buses - Delivering Victoria's Bus Plan

We know action is needed to protect and improve the environment, and that is why the Andrews Labor Government is excited to announce a ground breaking initiative to introduce zero emission buses in Victoria by 2025. This visionary step aligns with Victoria's Bus Plan and their commitment to sustainable transportation, reducing emissions and creating a greener future for all.

Victoria's Bus Plan outlines a comprehensive vision for improving public transportation across the state, prioritising efficiency, accessibility and environmental sustainability. As part of this plan, the implementation of zero emission buses on metro bus services will commence with the recontracting of bus service contracts expiring in 2025.



SRL East Update

Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) is a city and state-shaping project that will transform Victoria's public transport system, connecting our suburbs and making travel easier and more convenient.

The new underground station at Burwood will deliver better access to Deakin University, one of Australia's biggest universities for thousands of staff and students and connect locals to Melbourne's train network – providing faster and more convenient access to key destinations across Melbourne. Trains will be running by 2035.

Construction of SRL East from Cheltenham to Box Hill is ramping up, with the first phase of works in Burwood underway to establish the launch site for some of the tunnel boring machines that will dig the twin tunnels from 2026.

As part of the works, the Suburban Rail Loop Authority (SRLA) constructed a new park and playground between Cumming Street and Gillard Street and new BBQ facilities off Highbury Road at Lundgren Reserve. These facilities are an alternative to Sinnott Street Reserve, which is closed so that the new underground SRL Burwood Station can be safely built.

Free Rego for Eligible Apprentices

For those starting out in apprenticeships, the budget can often be tight. That's why the Victorian Government is investing in free registration for eligible apprentices like carpenters, joiners, bricklayers, plumbers, electricians and chefs.

Eligible apprentices can apply for the free vehicle registration via the **myVicRoads** portal on the VicRoads website.

A Message from Victoria Police and Your **Monash Local Area Commander, Matt Volk**

Monash Local Area Commander, Inspector Matt Volk wants all residents in the Mount Waverley and Ashwood areas to be aware of an increased number of house break-ins during the night and the early hours of the morning.

"Offenders are breaking into houses to steal car keys, before taking vehicles while you sleep. This is often made easier for the offender, with many residents leaving their doors unlocked and garage remotes in their unlocked vehicles.

"I want our community to know that their police are doing a significant amount of work every day and night. We have had considerable success arresting those responsible for these break ins and we remain firmly committed to this work."

A large-scale police operation is currently in place with a range of Police tasked to Operation Trinity which runs overnight, 7 nights a week. This includes uniform police, covert patrols, specialist units including Highway Patrol, Air Wing and the Dog Squad.

"We can commit all the resources we have, however I need the community to play their part and secure their houses and vehicles." We all need to be contributing to community safety so that Monash continues to be a great place to live, work and play.

The following are some simple steps to safeguard your homes:

- Install good quality locks on doors and windows
- Lock all doors and windows as unlocked side and rear doors are the most common entry points for burglars
- Ensure garage doors and internal access doors to the house and backyard are locked
- Ensure gates are closed and locked


Steps to reduce the risk of your car been stolen from your house:

- Lock your car at all times-even if parked in the garage
- Secure your car keys and garage remote and never leave them in your car
- Remove all valuables from your car

Insp. Volk urges the community to call Triple Zero (000) to report any suspicious behaviour at the time it is occurring. This gives Police the best opportunity to respond as quickly as possible, and to apprehend an offender if a crime is in progress.
